# FORMER RFA DILIGENCE

The Disposal Services Authority (DSA) is undertaking the sale of the Former RFA Diligence (ex Stena Inspector) a forward repair ship of the Royal Fleet Auxiliary which was launched in 1981 as a support ship for North Sea oil rigs and was chartered by the British government to support naval activities during the 1982 Falklands War and was later bought outright as a fleet maintenance vessel providing service for both ships and submarines away from their home ports.
